Use this guide to reflect on love, sacrifice, distance, and the ways we stay connected across time and uncertainty.



BEFORE WATCHING

Set the stage and open hearts and minds.

- What does it mean to stay connected to someone when you cannot be with them?
- Have you ever had to love someone through distance, time, or uncertainty?
- What helps people endure long periods of waiting or not knowing?



WHILE WATCHING

Notice how time, loss, and love shape the choices people make.

- How does separation affect the bond between parent and child?
- When do characters act from fear, and when do they act from love?
- How does time change the meaning of sacrifice?



AFTER WATCHING

Reflect together and make meaning.

- What part of the story felt most emotionally true to you?
- How does the film portray grief, hope, and endurance?
- What does the story suggest about whether love can outlast absence?



TRY THIS

Bring the themes into your own life.

- Write a short note to someone important to you about what remains true even when life is uncertain.
- Name one relationship that has helped orient you during a hard season.
- Talk about one way love gives meaning to sacrifice.
